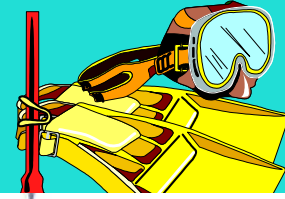

AQUACULTURE SPECIALISTS ARE EMPLOYED BY PRIVATE INDUSTRY AND BY GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES. IN MAINE ALONE THERE ARE OVER 80 PRIVATELY OWNED BUSINESSES AS WELL AS STATE AND FEDERAL AGENCIES THAT EMPLOY AQUACULTURE SPECIALISTS. AQUACULTURE BUSINESSES CAN BE FOUND THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES, RANGING FROM SALMON HATCHERIES IN THE NORTH ATLANTIC AND PACIFIC TO CATFISH FARMS ON THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER TO TROUT PONDS IN NEW YORK STATE. FEDERAL AND STATE AGENCIES AND REGIONAL COMMISSIONS ALSO EMPLOY AQUACULTURE SPECIALISTS. IN ADDITION, MEN AND WOMEN WITH DEGREES AND EXPERIENCE IN AQUACULTURE HAVE A UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY TO EXPLORE CAREERS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD.

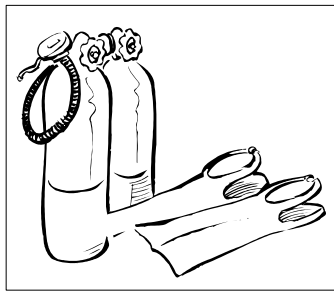
